Overview / The Activity Hall is an indoor open space for use as an indoor activity venue. Activities include five-a-side Football, Fencing, Archery, Basketball, Volleyball and Uni-Hoc. When use is given over to groups they are instructed that a responsible adult must be present at all times. All equipment for Instructor led activities are securely locked away during group use.
